1 Kaysone Phomvihane's Cave

Kaysone Phomvihane (13 December 1920 – 21 November 1992) was a politician and revolutionary who served as the first General Secretary and Chairman of the Central Committee of the Lao People's Revolutionary Party, the first Prime Minister, and the second President of the Lao People's Democratic Republic. He also held other important positions. Kaysone is considered the country's supreme leader and one of its most respected founding fathers. His portrait is featured on the Lao kip currency note.

2 Nouhak Phoumsavanh's Cave

Nouhak Phoumsavanh (09 April 1914 – 09 September 2008) was Minister of Finance and Economy in the Pathet Lao government and later became President of the Lao PDR. In his later years, he frequently visited rural areas to promote economic development and poverty reduction. His jeep, a gift from the Soviet Union, remains parked in this cave's garage.

3 Souphannouvong's Cave

Souphannouvong (13 July 1909–09 January 1995) of royal birth, was a leader of the revolutionary Pathet Lao movement, Chairman of the Lao Patriotic Front and the first President of the Lao People's Democratic Republic. He was also known as the "Red Prince" due to his involvement in the Pathet Lao revolutionary movement, despite his royal lineage. This cave was his home throughout the conflict. As a trained civil engineer, he designed his home, which was built outside the caves.

4 Phoumi Vongvichid's Cave

Phoumi Vongvichid (6 April 1909 – 7 January 1994) was a founding member of the Pathet Lao. He served as second Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Education, Sports, and Religion after the establishment of the Lao People's Democratic Republic, with a focus on education and culture. He also served as acting president and established a schooling curriculum in the caves.

5 Khamtay Siphandone's Cave

Khamtay Siphandone (08 February 1924 –) was a general in the Lao People's Army, held several important positions, including the second Chairman of the Central Committee of the Lao People's Revolutionary Party, the second Prime Minister of the Lao People's Democratic Republic, and the fourth President of the Lao People's Democratic Republic, and became the Supreme Leader of Laos after the death of Kaysone Phomvihane. This cave leads to a number of military caves, including one of the main caves used as a conference room for military command. These series of caves were also used as barracks during air-raids.

6 Xanglot Cave

Xanglot Cave
This huge natural cave, quite different from the leader's caves, formed the central area where large gatherings and meetings were held, and also served as a venue for musical and dance performances by local and foreign artists.

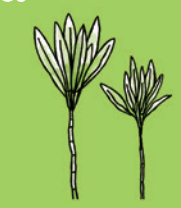

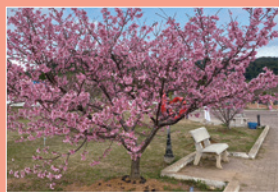

This park features 300 Japanese cherry blossom trees. The cherry blossom (Sakura) peak season is typically from December to January.



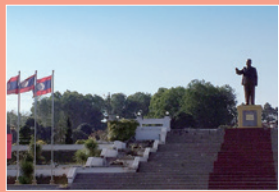
Minnano Cafe
